About 1890, Vallauris was a major center of artistic ceramics. Delphin Massier (1836-1907) was known for his naturalistic animals. The bull walks with its head turned, a dynamic posture typical of late 19th-century naturalistic productions. The white enamel corresponds to Vallauris' decorative research, often inspired by fine earthenware and Japonism.
