Beautiful pair of Louis XIII style armchairs in walnut, with high backs. Each armchair rests on four "sheep bone" legs, connected by an H-shaped crotch, also in sheep bone, as is the high crosspiece connecting the two front legs. Each back is steeply sloped, providing great seating comfort. The armrests are upholstered with a fully padded sleeve and rest on console supports. The seat is very comfortable, having been recently reupholstered (see photo), As for the upholstery, it has been done with a small-stitch tapestry , we point out the presence of a very small stain is on the front of the seat of one of the armchairs (see photo) Beautiful studded finish in aged brass. Some minor wear repairs have been made to the ends of the legs (see photo) . Note a slight lack on a crotch
