Description

Assiette En Porcelaine De Sèvres (XIXe Siècle)A plate in Sèvres porcelain, decorated with ivy leaves in gold on the border (ivy frieze, a classic motif of the manufacture). The center features the letter N under the imperial crown of Napoleon III. This plate is part of the service used at the Pavillon de Breteuil. The presence of the Louis-Philippe mark on the back and the Napoleon III cipher illustrate the political transitions of the 19th century and the Empire's re-emploo of royal services. Mid-19th century production (1846 production, decorated under the Second Empire)Visible at Galerie Courcelles Antiquités, 97 rue de Courcelles, in the 17th arrondissement of Paris.
