### Description

A pair of Louis XVI style gilt bronze and patinated metal andirons. The decoration simulates a fluted column base, surmounted by a tripod cassollette depicting a fire pot and a pine cone. Appliqué decoration of vine leaves and laurel branches completes the design. An antique Louis XVI piece, executed around 1840. Iron fittings are included. These andirons are a copy of a Louis XVI period example held at the Louvre, reference OA 10535 (see photo). A very fine, prestigious, and decorative model. H x W x D = 42 x 42 x 25 cm
