Description

Italian lantern made of sheet iron painted in red and dark green, enhanced with gilded details.

Hexagonal structure adorned with gilded columns and openwork motifs, topped by a small lantern with floral decoration. The piece is in an eclectic style with Neo-Gothic influences.

The lantern was designed to be mounted at the end of a pole rather than suspended, for outdoor use--hence the presence of transparent panes protecting the flame from the wind.

Condition: signs of age-related wear, traces of oxidation, and slight deformations of the metal sheet. Some elements are missing or detached; one pane is absent, and other parts show losses or broken welds. Despite these alterations, it remains a rare and highly decorative object.
