Description

This original Antique Tile depicting a Horse Head was made in Portugal in the period of 1706-1750! The tile is made of an elegant white ceramic, detailed with a glazed finish and it is decorated with a Horse Head from the 18th century in a charming blue color. This Tile was part of a Large Tile Mural Panel. Item Details & Specifics: The late 17th century and the early 18th century was considered to be the 'Golden Age of the Tile', the so-called Cycle of the Masters. Mass production was started not just because of a greater internal demand, but also because of very large orders from Brazil. Large one-off orders were replaced by the less expensive use of repetitive tile patterns. Churches, monasteries, palaces and even houses were covered inside and outside with tiles, many with exuberant Baroque
