## Large Vermeil Flower Brooch From The Ecole De Nancy Art Nouveau Period

### Description

This spectacular brooch features a large rose stem in full bloom au naturel, with its branches and three leaves, frozen in a sinuous, Art Nouveau movement. The goldsmith-jewelers of the École de Nancy, founded by Émile Gallé in 1901, were behind the creation of these brooches with flowers au naturel motifs, available in several sizes and precious materials. Similar examples appear in Étienne Martin's book, Editions du Quotidien: BIJOUX ART NOUVEAU Nancy 1890-1920 Fully functional C-clasp brooch system. Brightly colored vermeil, beautiful hammerwork on the petals. Boar's head hallmark on the back of the stem, confirming French origin. FIRST CONDITION, Art Nouveau period circa 1900.
