Painted in the 19th century in direct reference to the great Flemish compositions of the 17th century, the work follows the traditional codes of the genre with accuracy. The composition is rich yet controlled, the palette nuanced, and the neutral background enhances the overall balance. The bouquet features a wide variety of flowers including peonies, tulips and wild blossoms. The brushwork is lively and expressive, with a particularly successful use of color. Deep reds interact with vivid blues, bright yellows and soft whites, creating a composition that feels both

dense and harmonious. The vase plays a central role. Classical in form, it is decorated with a relief motif inspired by antiquity, in the taste of neoclassical productions. It anchors the composition and reinforces its connection to earlier traditions while adding refinement. Light is delicately handled, modelling the petals and enhancing depth and volume throughout the composition. The painting is presented in a remarkable richly carved and gilded wooden frame of excellent quality, in perfect condition, which naturally extends the presence of the work.
