### Description

Bronze sculpture with a golden-brown patina, representing "La colère d'Achille" (Achilles' wrath) resting on a marble base, signed on the back, stamped Susses Frères fondeur....Epoque XXe.( chips to the marble )Sculptor Constant Roux (1865-1942) began and brilliantly concluded his career with a single work: La Colère d'Achille. It opened the doors to the Villa Médicis in the 1894 Grand Prix de Rome competition, and won him a medal of honor at the Salon de la Société des Artistes Français in 1930. Indeed, this powerful statue, abundantly duplicated in bronze, often overshadows the artist who conceived it. However, Constant Roux's endearing personality and talent merit closer attention: supported by the French state and a number of loyal patrons, foremost among them
