An elegant vintage ring in gold and silver, set with an amethyst, a green stone (likely peridot), and diamonds. The combination of these three colors--purple, green, and white--corresponds to the famous color code of the British suffragettes, symbolizing dignity, hope, and purity, respectively. This type of jewelry was worn in early 20th-century England in connection with the women's suffrage movement, particularly that of the Women's Social and Political Union. The gold setting with silver mountings is characteristic of English jewelry from the Edwardian period (circa 1900-1915).
