Description

Charming religious painting depicting Saint Bernardine of Siena, 15th-century Franciscan monk, famous preacher and great propagator of Christ's monogram "IHS", here featured several times in the composition. The saint is depicted in his study, seated in front of a desk covered with a red sheet, quill in hand, absorbed in writing. His gaze rises to a celestial apparition composed of cherubs' heads emerging from the clouds, framing the radiant monogram. To the right, two putti hold a banner also bearing the "IHS" symbol, reinforcing the devotional dimension of the scene. The composition, balanced and narrative, is part of a Franciscan iconographic tradition that was widespread in the 16th and 18th centuries. Note the warm treatment of the palette, dominated by browns and ochres, as well as the
