Chased and gilded bronze sculpture depicting a majestic eagle holding a sphere in its talons. His head is turned to his right and his wings spread asymmetrically. The sphere is pierced by two threaded holes allowing two different positions. Rich in detail, the high-quality chasing is finely executed with beautiful reliefs. A symbol of power and majesty in the purest Empire tradition, this piece is originally the element that finalizes the decoration of a clock at its top.
