Enea Vico(1523-1567): Suite of Emblems III "Infortunium", etching and burin 8 X 8 cm approx., print on laid paper 13 X 12 cm, mounted from the top on a 21 X 15 cm sheet. Title in the composition and legend in Latin at the head. Very fine period proof. The brilliant Vico who, despite his short life, left numerous prints, worked first for Cosimo I de Medici, then for Alfonso II d'Este, Duke of Ferrara of Ferrara, where he died.
