Large three-top mahogany veneer with butterfly wings and light wood fillets framing a black wood framing a black wood fillet. Estamped on the iron under the top "Escalier de Cristal Cristal - Paris". The tops are ringed and encircled by a bronze belt. The finely-moulded feet are bronze sabots. Original varnish, please note micro-scratches. L'Escalier de Cristal is a house is a house located in the Palais Royal. It was only at the end of the reign of Louis-Philippe Louis-Philippe's reign, on the initiative of the Pannier brothers, the store expanded its activity to the furniture trade, and began to manufacture furniture around 1870. The Escalier de Cristal won a gold medal at the 1900 Paris Exposition Universelle. The closed its doors in 1923.
