Monstrance-reliquary, harmonious in its geometric construction, in carved lacquered wood, decorated with three winged angels and foliage. It houses a montage of silver wires forming a floral decoration that accommodates in a poly-lobed niche, a bagged ex-ossibus relic of Saint Severus (S. Severi Martyr). At Bizya in Thrace, around 304, Saint Severi, martyr. It is said that during the reign of Diocletian and Maximin martyrdom, he converted centurion Memnon to the faith and followed him in his passion. Presence of four episcopal seals on the back. South German or North Italian work, 18th century. Dimensions 61.5 cm high and 28 cm wide. Beautiful condition. Reference 169
