It's a complicated exercise, because looking at it, you'd almost forget yourself! God, the colors! I'm like a child in front of a confectioner's window. It's amazing. This perfect harmony, this balance in the ultra-graphic composition, these interlocking motifs subtly organized all over the surface! I notice the deliberate absence of a central field.
