Superb Italian chandelier in Murano glass, attributed to designer Toni Zuccheri for the Venini house, emblematic of 70s design. This model is distinguished by its composition in textured glass tubes known as "tronchi", arranged in a cascade on two levels. The glass, both solid and finely crafted, has an organic, vibrant texture that elegantly captures and diffuses light, creating a particularly refined sparkling effect. The metal structure (patinated brass) harmoniously supports the whole, bringing a warm, authentic touch to the piece. The ensemble perfectly evokes the work of Toni Zuccheri, renowned for his sculptural creations and his freer, more organic approach to Murano glass within Venini.
