Period albumen print signed in the plate (circa 1870). Felix Bonfils (1831-1885)- Photo Format 22x 28.5 cm- Sous passe-partout 40x50cm "Muslim schoolmaster in Syria". A Muslim schoolmaster in Syria with three young pupils are staged in a studio setting faithfully recreating a Middle Eastern interior, with a painted background depicting an archway and a patterned carpet. The schoolmaster, dressed in traditional costume, teaches from a large book, surrounded by children also holding books. Felix Bonfils was a French photographer (1831 - 1885). He learned photography from Niepce de Saint-Victor, nephew of Nicéphore Niepce. He opened his photographic studio in 1867 in Beirut, Lebanon. He is famous for his photographs of architecture and landscapes of Lebanon, Egypt,
