Beaux-Arts d'Alger from 1937 to 1945. He executed several mural decorations, including one for the foyer of the Algiers Opera in 1938. He was a member of the Indépendants from 1956 to 1968. After 1962, he moved to Montreuil, where he exhibited abstract works with geometric tendencies: Auguste Harzic, who never ceased to be interested in sacred art from all eras and all latitudes, was in search of a secret: that of producing a work of art devoid of all transcendence, but by the very nature of its immanent plastic qualities able to convey with new intensity man's place in the universe. In the 70s, he produced shimmering, rigorous works like the beginnings of a humanist alchemy, magnified by beauty.
