This is an antique European Tetex rug woven in Germany during the first quarter of the 20th century, around the 1920s. It is also known as a "Janus" rug, due to its fleur-de-lis weave. It is a wool rug on a cotton base. The history of the Tetex rug... Europeans love to have Persian and other oriental rugs in their homes or offices, which is why Persian rugs have always been in high demand in Europe. During the 1920s and 1930s, Persian and Caucasian rugs were so popular that weavers in Persia and the Caucasus couldn't keep up with orders from Western merchants. As a result, some merchants decided to produce Persian and Caucasian designs in Europe. Some started in Germany, where they are known as Tetex, and some were made in Austria using a different technique. Its rich and detailed
