He then exhibited in 1938 in Florence at the Galerie Cavalseni et Botti... remark: after Italy's armistice in 1943, he was taken prisoner by the Germans.by the Germans, who were quite lenient in view of his status as a painter.painter: at the Château de Rambouillet, he painted portraits of General Heinkel and Marshal Rommel...The artist eventually escaped and escaped and remained in hiding until the liberation...success, he lived a
