The handles are made of finely embossed and chased silver, decorated with delicate floral and vegetal motifs, typical of the French style of the late 19th century. The richly worked functional parts also feature engraved and openwork decoration, bringing finesse and refinement to the ensemble. The original case, sheathed in leather-like imitation crocodile decoration and lined with satin, bears the mark: "H. Gavillon, Coutelier-Orfèvre, Dijon", attesting to quality regional manufacture.
