Description

Important oil on canvas from the 18th century (height 1m32), depicting Mary Magdalene mourning the death of Christ. A major figure in Christianity, she is the first witness to Christ's resurrection and is responsible for announcing the news to the other disciples. Our painting depicts her walking on the heights of Jerusalem, which can be seen in the background of the scene, on her way to Christ's tomb. This oil painting is in very good condition, having benefited from a conservative restoration (respraying and minor repainting etc...) as well as a lining, both of which are quite old.
