Orange enameled theater binoculars, accented with a light geometric pattern. The base is in gilded brass. wheel, optical rings and grip cabochon are in mother-of-pearl. cabochon are in polished mother-of-pearl. The system is functional, with clear vision. The beige cotton protective bag is lined with silk on the inside and fastened with a double by a double satin-braided cord. The two mother-of-pearl rings bear the inscription "L.KLEON - OPTICIEN" and "33 PASS. JOUFFROY -PARIS". The telescopic socket, also in brass enameled with the same motif. This highly feminine is not in perfect condition. The enamel is marked at the point of contact between the handle and the right optic (visible on the photos). Late 19th or early 20th century. 20th century.
