Description

True Cross pendant medallion - 19th century - Italy
Oval-shaped devotional reliquary, in sealed silver-plated metal
Description
The obverse presents, under glass, a neat composition on a red textile background, adorned with a cross formed of wooden fragments arranged in a Latin cross, surrounded by rays of gilded paperolles. These elements correspond to a classic presentation of a relic of the True Cross (Ex Ligno Crucis). The mounting is finely executed, with textile framing and radiant decoration, typical of 19th-century devotional production. The reverse is closed with antique guarantee paper, held in place by crossed threads and sealed with an armorial/ecclesiastical red wax seal, ensuring the integrity of the reliquary.

Good overall state of preservation. Normal wear and tear on the metal
