Born into an artistic family, he was the son of American painter Frank Boggs. Early on, he worked in his father's studio on rue de Clignancourt in Paris, which was one of his first and most influential artistic apprenticeships. A major player in the Paris School. Initially, he had also studied architecture, but abandoned this course of study to devote himself entirely to painting. The influence of his family environment and this
