Pablo under the command of Brigadier Marquis de Spinola; B. The polacca Digent commanded by His Excellency Prince Pio; C. The 10-gun brig S. José / commanded by Lieutenant Commander Antonio Torres and the aforementioned 8-gun polacca. The brig faces forward to rescue the ship D, which is a French ***** that, having lost its masts in a storm, was sailing adrift towards the coast between Co de Palos and Isla Grosa. / On the three Spanish warships, the ensign and director of this Nautical Academy, José Ruiz de Ruiz, sailed, and in his memory, he made this drawing as a
