### Description

A chiselled and gilded bronze vase in the shape of a binet, resting on a tripod base adorned with three putti heads; the circular base is decorated with flaming torches set within medallions. Feuchère may have owned this model, since the sale of his stock in 1829 mentions bas-reliefs by E. Martincourt. Let's also mention the pair of torches of this model delivered around 1845 to the Duc d'Aumale for the Château de Chantilly (ill. in P. Verlet, *Les bronzes dorés français du XVIIIe siècle*, Paris, p. 387).
