This refined and important sterling silver epergne centerpiece, crafted in the Georgian period (mid-18th century), stands out for its excellent craftsmanship and rich decoration, the result of expert casting, embossing, perforation, and finely chased workmanship. The structure rests on an articulated and dynamic base, resting on elegant feet shaped with naturalistic motifs. Curved arms branch out harmoniously from the central body, supporting removable baskets, flanked by a large upper bowl, creating a balanced interplay of volumes and solids and voids. The perforated surfaces and chased floral details testify to the high level of English goldsmithing of the period. Signed with two initials, "M and E." Originally intended to enrich aristocratic tables for the presentation of fruit, sweets, or flowers, this
