Description

Porcelain pie made by Samson seculo XIX. The Samson factory is famous for the high quality of its porcelain and its texture, with great technical expertise, of its European decorative models. The table has a bright white background and a beautiful table with delicate, rich moss, which gives elegance and movement in the form, enhancing the richness of the pictorial decoration. Decorative floral apparatus made of a central bouquet of great refinement, affiancato da piccoli motivi floristici sparsi lungo la tesa. Nel dettaglio si riconoscono:

1. Central rose, dominant element of the composition, painted with morbid smoke that does not restore the volume to the delicateness of the petalis.
2. Rose and boccioli in cream tone and giallo

outfit, creano depth and chromatic harmony.

3. Viole pensiero in vivaci tonalità viola e lilla, caratterizzate da petali ampi e variegati.

4. Piccoli flowers in red and orange, probably decorated with ornate flowers, included as an element of contrast and vivacity.

5. Foglie verdi ampie et naturalistiche, dipped with careful attention to chiaroscuro, che incorniciano il bouquet e ne accentuano l'equilibrio compositivo.

The picture is fine, precise and layered, with light weight and refined tone passages, index of manual cleaning of the high quality. The table is located in the historical and evocative taste of the Ottoman Empire, with strong richness of porcelain flowers from the Settecento, reinterpreted with decorative sensitivity and technical characteristics of the Samson manufacturer.
