The stone depicts the bust of Athena, goddess of wisdom and war, in left-facing profile. She wears a crested helmet and a suit of armour adorned with a snake -- a distinctive iconographic detail evoking the aegis and her role as divine protector. Wear marks consistent with ancient use. Excellent state of conservation. Former English private collection, acquired on the English art market in the 2000s .
