The artist, known for his ironic take on 19th-century society, here delivers a vivid, expressive scene. Four characters are depicted, each accompanied by a handwritten annotation. The line is precise, caricatured without being mocking. We read the names "M. Mignolet, ex-quincaillier", "Adrien, ancien voyageur", as well as a duo entitled "La vieille dame, l'invitée et la servante". These figures seem to come from a bourgeois theater, sketched on the spot with great mastery. This drawing is a precious testimony to the graphic talent of Monnier, famous for his scenes of manners and Parisian caricatures.
