Victorian burr-walnut veneered vanity case, mid-19th century, the hinged lid enclosing a removable mirror, the interior fitted with a lift-out compartment and equipped with various boxes, cut crystal surmounted, with silver guilloché chasing and crowned perched lions on the lids, maker's mark JH, Halstaff & Hannaford (William Halstaff & Thomas Charles Hannaford), with a tray partially fitted with manicure items and pencils, scissors hook, above a tray, the lock mechanism marked S. MORDAN & Co. LONDON and PATENT with crown seal, 14 cm high, 30 cm wide, 23 cm deep. Good overall condition; brush missing from box
