This sheet presents a particularly accomplished study of an Ionic capital, executed as part of a late 19th-century French academic education. The quality of the line, the precision of the linear drawing and the mastery of proportions reflect an advanced exercise, probably carried out during an internal competition. The handwritten inscription mentioning a "troisième prix d'émulation" lends the work particular interest, as these distinctions came to reward the best students in the art schools

Leroy, follows in the rigorous tradition of studying the classical orders, the foundation of architectural and decorative drawing apprenticeship. This type of sheet, both pedagogical and aesthetic, is sought after today for the finesse of its execution and its testimony to 19th-century teaching methods. By its balance between technical rigor and decorative sense, this work is a representative and decorative example of French academic drawing. Condition: Good overall condition.
