Portrait of a Young Man, pastel on paper, signed and dated E. Bouchardy, 1819 31 x 25.5 cm framed; oval 19 x 15 cm Portrait of a young man executed in pastel, with soft modelling and careful attention to physiognomy. The work has undergone a very light conservation treatment. The sheet is rectangular but conceived for an oval presentation, in keeping with early 19th-century taste. 19th-century frame. Signed and dated at right: E. Bouchardy, 1819. Étienne Bouchardy (Paris, 1797 - Paris, 1849) belongs to the generation of French portraitists active between the Empire, the Restoration and the July Monarchy, who adapted small-scale portraiture on paper or ivory to the taste of an expanding private clientele. His works, appreciated for their clarity of structure and restrained modelling, are
