The work vividly illustrates a lively peasant interior, where characters bustle about in a warm, authentic atmosphere. The subtle play of light and the richness of detail reflect all the expertise of this school..Notable and relatively rare for this type of composition, the painting presents a beautiful overall clarity: the scene is legible, luminous, and offers a balanced palette that particularly highlights the figures and gestures of everyday life.Dated 1644 (partially visible in the rabbit), it is presented in an antique wooden frame that emphasizes its period character.Dimensions: 30 x 24 cm (unframed) ; 45 x 40 cm (framed).Adriaen van Ostade (1610-1685) is one of the great
