Description

Brown patina bronze medal depicting the portrait of French King Henri IV (1553 - 1610). This portrait is the work of the great royal medallist Guillaume DUPRÉ (1574 - 1647), whose works greatly influenced later productions. This 19th-century medal is signed under the arm: it reads Guillaume DUPRÉ. The face is finely chiseled, framed by his characteristic beard and strawberry is treated with great attention to detail. The bust is richly adorned with armor, and the king is wearing the Order of the Holy Spirit. This medal is presented in a stuccoed and black lacquered wood frame. As you can see from the photos, there is a chip on the right side. Format with frame: diameter: 24 cm. Format when viewed with medal alone: 16.50 cm.
