Glenys Gibson Napaltjarri is a Luritja woman born in 1968 in the Papunya community in central Australia. She has resided between the Papunya and Kintore (Walungurru) communities and now lives with her husband and a large family. She is the daughter of world-renowned Australian artist Ningura Naparulla, and her artistic style developed by learning from her mother, aunts and grandmother.
