



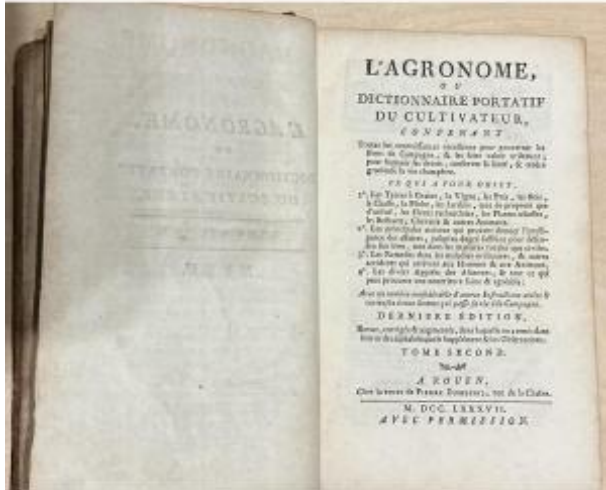

A fine 18th-century set in its original full mottled calf bindings, with raised bands and gilt fillets to the spines, and volume numbering to the spine.

Conceived as a practical dictionary for use in the rural world, this work brings together a wealth of useful knowledge relating to country life: crops, gardens, plants, animals, domestic economy, and various practical skills.

The set retains all the genuine charm of early bibliophily, with a sober and authentic appearance, typical of the practical books of the period.
