The interiorized expression of the face is in perfect harmony with the masterful drawing of the facial features, revealing the triangular-shaped eyes, pierced pupils and nostrils, thick lipstick lips with a well-defined furrow in the center of the upper lip. In the absence of a thermoluminescence test, it is difficult to confidently date this beautiful piece, the respect of the corpus and the remains of manganese oxide are reassuring.
