### Description

Japanese beauty admiring the Kirifuri waterfall in the province of Nikke 1898. She holds the handle of a parasol in her hand and wears beautifully printed fashionable clothes. Very beautiful diptych paralleling feminine beauty and the beauty of landscapes. The decoration is printed in blue with a touch of pink. Yoshu Chikanabu was the last undisputed master of Japanese printmaking in the last half of the 19th century. His work is essential in the transition between Ukiyo and the new Shin-Hanga style. Some folds and very fresh colors.
