### Description

Gemla rocking chair, "Isabella" model, Sweden, 1960s. Elegant Scandinavian rocking chair edited by Swedish manufacturer Gemla, based on a design by Karl-Axel Adolfsson, circa 1960. This emblematic model of Nordic design is distinguished by its sober, perfectly balanced lines: high backrest with vertical slats offering excellent support, sculpted armrests finished with characteristic handholds, and a curved wooden base resting on glides, testifying to Gemla's traditional expertise in the bentwood technique. The wooden structure of this model is a perfect example of the Nordic design style. The black-stained wood structure (ebenisé) lends a timeless elegance, while the seat upholstered with a suede cushion brings comfort and modernity. A typical piece of Scandinavian design from the 50s
