Description

Beautiful Flemish genre scene depicting a kitchen interior animated by several figures, attributed to Jan Baptist Lambrechts. Kitchen scene with figures and an abundance of vegetables. Oil on panel - Flemish school, early 18th century. The composition is organized around a seated figure in the foreground, slightly slouched in his chair, holding a jug, whose expressive attitude brings a touch of vivacity and humor to the scene. In the background, a woman presents a basket of potatoes to a man, while another figure can be made out in the half-light. The ensemble is enriched by an abundance of still life: cabbages, vegetables and kitchen utensils arranged on a table and on the floor, treated with a keen sense of material and volume. The play of chiaroscuro, characteristic of Flemish painting, highlights the

figures and objects, creating a warm, intimate atmosphere. This work is part of the tradition of Flemish kitchen scenes of the early 18th century, in the entourage of Jan Baptist Lambrechts, from whom it takes on several characteristics: Lively compositions mixing folk figures and still life. Expressive treatment of faces. Warm, contrasting palette. Attention to textures (textiles, vegetables, metal).
