### Description

An imposing icon of early Belgian Art Deco, this large apothecary cabinet, attributed to the prestigious De Coene workshops, embodies the refinement of craftsmanship and architectural elegance that marked this period. Created around 1920, it bridges the gap between the aesthetics of the late Belle Époque and the emerging modernist vocabulary that De Coene would later champion, resulting in a cabinet that is both rooted in tradition and resolutely forward-looking. The front features sculptural clarity: a high upper section with glass doors reveals generous shelves, ideal for displaying ceramics, glassware or carefully selected collections. Below, sliding wooden doors open onto additional storage space, their discreet metal handles and sleek geometry echoing the rigorous lines of early Art Deco
