



Sculptural Group - Meissen



Description

A refined, signed sculptural group in enameled porcelain produced by the renowned Meissen manufactory, dating back to the early 19th century. The composition, in late Rococo style, depicts an intimate and lively domestic scene: a seated young mother cares for a child, while a standing female figure--likely a wet nurse or governess--cares for the cradle. Completing the group is an elegant gentleman who observes with an empathetic attitude, contributing to a harmonious and emotional narrative. The ensemble is distinguished by its exceptional craftsmanship: the delicately modeled faces express naturalness and sweetness, while the garments, adorned with meticulous polychrome floral decorations, testify to the extremely high level of craftsmanship. enamels and the fine details, such as the ripples of the fabrics and the plant elements in the background, lend depth and movement to the scene. The contoured base, embellished with raised gold motifs, elegantly completes the piece, making it a perfect example of early 19th-century Meissen production, in which 18th-century tradition blends with a more intimate and narrative sensibility.
