### Description

18th Century,  
Italian Giltwood Baroque MirrorThe large  
and refined mirror, made in Turin in the middle  
of the 18th century, with  
original mercury glass, has a richly carved and  
gilded wooden frame.  
The frame  
that wraps with typical Baroque and rocaille  
motifs (called pannocchetta) the  
whole mirror of mixed shape, has an important  
and rich perforated cymas in  
which the ornaments are carved with  
phytomorphic and floral decorations. The  
cymatium, being slender upwards and perforated,  
lightens the richness of the  
ornaments making the whole graceful and well  
balanced, although very precious.

The volutes  
and the movement of the elaborate architecture of  
this mirror make it a  
particularly valuable object, characterized by a  
beautiful gilding from which  
emerges the warmth of the red color of the bole.
