Large, uncommon model with superb doors decorated with mahogany baguettes called astragles. This very handsome secretary features a magnificent interior with a theater with several arcades and drawers and a door. The drawers are decorated with lemon fillets and the door with an inlay representing the Georgian star. A sign that it is an 18th century Georgian piece. The door reveals two small drawers. The flap of the desk and the 4 drawers are decorated with a walnut inlay. We can find the same inlay on the upper part. The upper part is composed of two glass
