Rare and decorative polychrome plaster anatomical écorché depicting a stylized human body, treated in the spirit of ancient anatomical plates and in the taste of Gauthier d'Agoty's famous compositions "l'ange" for example. The piece presents a didactic vision of the muscular and bony system, with naturalistic polychromy contrasting red muscle masses with ivory bone structures. The modeling is expressive and deliberately synthetic, lending the whole a dimension that is both scientific and artistic. The écorché is mounted on a Plexiglas plate, itself integrated into a modern frame, creating an interesting contrast between ancient subject and contemporary presentation.
