He was a student at the Antwerp Academy under Guillaume-Jacques Herreyns and at the Brussels Academy, where he became a professor. Author of a famous treatise on perspective in 1834, Bossuet is known for his selection of picturesque sites depicted using his mastery of perspective and animating them with small, colorful figures.
