Louis XIII-style solid oak bookcase, 19th-century work. This handsome piece of furniture is distinguished by its rich, balanced architecture, directly inspired by the Louis XIII style. It is made of solid oak and features a front punctuated by powerful twisted columns, characteristic of this aesthetic, framing three glazed doors. The upper part opens with three glazed leaves to showcase books and objects. The jambs are adorned with salomonic columns resting on sculpted bases, bringing relief and depth to the whole. The central door, set slightly forward and embellished by a molded frame with scalloped decoration, reinforces the symmetry and elegance of the cabinet. The recessed lower section is composed of molded solid panels, offering discreet storage spaces. The whole unit rests on a
